We expect our players to...

Take responsibility for being present at planned meetings/training sessions/games.

Communicate clearly with Coaches and Club officers.

Be respectful in behaviour, word and deed - including on social media.

Be aware of and adhere to BFC Youths Code of Ethics on www.bohemianfc.com. (See Players Code of Conduct below)

Bring & use hand sanitiser before & after all training sessions

Code of Conduct for Players

Always show respect for team-mates, Coaches, opponents and officials.

Always turn up on time for matches and training.

Always play to win but accept defeat like proper sportspersons.

Always have commitment to your club and pride in your performance.

Arrive for training and matches with the proper gear and boots – it's your bag so carry it yourself and be responsible for it.

Listen to advice given and ask questions if you don't understand.

Help out with equipment before and after matches and training.

Let the Coach know – as soon as possible – if you are injured or sick.

Bullying will not be tolerated and if you feel you are being bullied feel safe to tell the Coach or Youth officers.

We expect parents to...

Facilitate their player in being present at planned meetings/training sessions/games.

Communicate clearly with Coaches about scheduling, commitments and expectations including payment schedules and other Club info.

Be respectful in behaviour, word and deed - including on social media.

Be aware of and adhere to BFC Youths Code of Ethics on www.bohemianfc.com. (See Parents Code of Conduct below)

Ensure your child arrives to training with appropriate clothing & footwear, shin guards, drinking water, and hand sanitiser

Code of Conduct for Parents

Always show respect for all players, opponents, coaches and officials.

Have realistic expectations for your player and don't put them under undue pressure.

Ensure that your player arrives on time for training and matches and that safe arrangements are in place for getting them to and from venues.

Leave coaching to the coaches.

Respect the coaches decisions.

Assist when asked.

Support the Club's fund-raising activities where possible.

Accept disappointment, praise good work and refrain from criticising.

Emphasise skill development and practice over winning, how beneficial they are for your own and other players.

De-emphasise games and competition in the lower age groups.

If your player requires hospital treatment a parent must attend.

COVID NOTICE:

All players should bring their own hand sanitiser and water bottle with their name on it to training and matches.

Please do not bring your child to training or matches if:

- your child has symptoms of cough, high temperature (38 degrees celsius or higher), shortness of breath, sudden loss of sense of smell/taste in the past 14 days;
- your child has been diagnosed with confirmed or suspected Covid-19 infection in the past 14 days;
- your child has been in close contact with a person with a confirmed or suspected case of Covid-19 in the past 14 days;
- your child has been advised by a doctor to self-isolate at this time.
