Mini All-Ireland Key Information

- 1. Only open to children who play with Kilmacud Crokes or children who are unattached to a GAA club. The Mini All Ireland's are run under the GAA's Code of Behaviour (underage). Players, Managers, Referees & Co-ordinators are to be treated with respect and all the games to be played in the right spirit.
- 2. Due to expected demand and limited space and time we may have to cap numbers at some age groups. Places will be filled on a first come first served basis.
- 3. Parking During the event parking will be limited. Please Park responsibly or try to leave the car at home.
- 4. Gumshields <u>must</u> be worn for all Football competitions
- 5. Helmets must be worn for all Hurling competitions
- 6. Each participant will be presented with their own jersey and must be worn in every game.
- 7. A list of teams and timetable will be posted Kilmacud Crokes club website before the competition starts
- 8. A parent/guardian must accompany children at all times.
- 9. The decision of the organising committee relating to all aspects of the Mini All Irelands is final

Games will be played on the main pitch in Glenalbyn from 4.30pm each evening.

The Registration fee is €38 per child per week for club members and €50 per child per week for non-members.A discount where more than one child in a family is registered for an individual week as Follows:

€10 on 2nd Child, €20 on 3rd Child, €30 on 4th Child. Registration fees are subject to an overall cumulative cap of €145 per family for the entire event. If entering a number of children across the weeks and the total comes to more than €145, you should instead choose the Family Registration option.

Please don't try to enter a child into a competition that is not the correct Year of Birth for your son/daughter. They will not be allowed play out of their age group. The Club reserves the right to fully refund any registration that has been registered under the wrong age grade

Refunds will only be granted on the following circumstances: (A) as the player is medically certified as being unable to participate in the Mini all Ireland event or (b) The cancelation ocurs 7 days before the first day of the event for which the player has been registered
