

St. Peters Dunboyne GAA – Camp Terms and Conditions

Health Questionnaire

You MUST have completed a Health Questionnaire for EACH child on the morning of EACH day of camp (completing this the night before DOES NOT cover you).

We will send a link on a separate email with a video that explains how to sign up & complete this health questionnaire, which will be specific to your Cul Camp (current entries for your club activities DO NOT count, a new entry is required)

Drive-Through Drop Off

St Peter's GAA will be implementing a “drive-through drop off” system for our camp. You are asked to follow the following instructions each morning of camp

When you arrive at your club, please follow the directions to join the queue in your car. When you reach the top of the queue you will be in the “drop off zone”.

You and your child/children are asked to remain in your car until you reach this “drop off zone” at the top of the queue.

We will start admitting children into the camp from 9.30am at earliest.

Checking Your Health Questionnaire

We would ask that when you reach the COVID Supervisor in the "drop off zone" that you sanitise your kids & your own hands

Before we can admit children into the camp our COVID Supervisors will need to verify you have logged a Health Questionnaire in respect of the camp for each child, each morning.

To prove this please have a screenshot of the submitted form for each child on your phone available to show the COVID supervisor

Any child that does not have a completed health questionnaire that has been submitted that morning (every morning) will NOT be allowed entry to the camp until the form is complete.

By having this complete for each child before leaving for camp with the submitted form screenshot on your phone will help speed up the process for everyone.

Once the COVID supervisor has seen proof of a newly completed health questionnaire your child/children will be allowed to enter the camp.

Children Entering The Camp

Once the above is complete the COVID Supervisor will then direct the children to the pitch Supervisor who will direct them to the zone that each attendee is on

If there is any problem with the above you will be directed to park in a specific area where the COVID Supervisors will assist you when possible.

Afternoon Collection From Camp

Afternoon collection will work on a "queue & collect" system. Please follow the below steps to help with a smooth and efficient collection each day.

When you arrive please park your car and follow directions to the "queue & collect" area. Please make sure to follow social distancing from other parents.

At 2pm we will have all the camp participants ready to leave.

Only when you reach the top of the queue, your child/children will be allowed to come to meet you. This will be indicated by the camp supervisor

Once you have collected your child/children we would ask that you don't hang around to allow others to collect their children.

The same criteria will apply to collecting Junior Campers, with the exception being that collection will be at 12:00 in this case.

What About Rainy Days?

Please be aware we will NOT have access to indoor facilities so camps will be weather dependent.

Please ensure that children have appropriate gear and equipment on rainy days.

If the weather is too bad to run the camp a decision will be made on the morning if needs be and parents will be informed at the camp.

Bags will remain outside all-day

What Do Kids Need?

Each child must have their own bag with the following

Hand sanitiser for use throughout the day

Fully packed lunch for 3 x 10-minute breaks

Water bottle with their name clearly marked

Gumshield, hurl & helmet

Any inhalers or medication

Everything in the bag to be in a waterproof container or bag

NO MOBILE PHONES are allowed with kids on a camp

Kids should also have a rain jacket/change of clothes.

All of the above steps will be in place each morning & afternoon (Monday – Friday)

Camps run from Monday to Friday 10am to 2pm (Junior Campers from 10:00 to 12:00)
