PLAYERS CODE: On and Off the Field, I will:

Never argue with or complain about referee's calls or decisions. Never engage in public criticism of the match officials.

Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment.

Treat all players as you would like to be treated, speak to my team mates, the opposition, referees, coaches and managers with respect.

Remember we all make mistakes.

Remember that the goals of the game are to have fun, improve your skills and feel good. Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at game's end.

FEES

Due to the way registration is now being done; Saint Patrick's Boys AFC have had to put a strict fees payment policy in place. Full fees need to be paid to the club before registration takes place. A payment plan is in place using the clubforce app where you can pay in 4 stages ie. 4 monthly payments of €25 Aug-Nov. You will be registered after first payment is paid as you have made a commitment to pay the rest of the fee with your card.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club:

- Be required to apologise to team-mates, the opposing team, referee or team manager.
- Receive a verbal warning from the coach.
- Receive a written warning from the club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Not be selected for the team.
- Be required to serve a suspension, after committee review.
- Be fined.
- Be required to leave the club.
