COVID19related parent/guardian responsibilities

Parents/guardians need to be aware of the responsibilities associated with the return to training in the current environment.

While we expect training to be a fun and safe environment for the kids, and training will be full contact in much the same way we're all used to, there will be some changes, and there will be additional expectations made of the players and parents as set out below:

- Players must be dropped off by a member of their household, or can travel by themselves if old enough. Carpooling is discouraged.
- Parents/guardians should drop off players and leave promptly without leaving their car. If for whatever reason, a parent needs to stay at training, they need to remain in their car. No siblings or other children can attend the training venue while training is on.
- Players must arrive in training gear, and bring a water bottle labelled with their name.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at the beginning and end of training, but players are encouraged to bring their own supplies.
- Players to bring home all personal items and washed immediately. If bibs are used, the player needs to bring theirs home, wash it, and return it next week.
- On pick up, parents must stay in their cars, and leave promptly once players are collected.

A player must stay home if:

- They have been in contact with COVID-19 or a suspected COVID-19 case in the last 14 days.
- They have been overseas in the past 14 days.
- They have flu-like symptoms or feel unwell.
- They have a temperature of 38c or higher.
- They experience sudden onset cough or shortness of breath.
- They experience a sudden loss of sense of taste and smell.
