

**Cork Con Easter Rugby Camp 2026**  
**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

Dear parent/guardian,

Thank you for registering your child for this year's summer camp at Cork Constitution FC.

The camp will run from Tuesday 7th to Friday 10th April 2026 at the club grounds Temple Hill.

Camp hours are from 9.30am-1.00pm.

A packed lunch and water is required each day. Please apply sunscreen if necessary and pack a light rain jacket. In the case of heavy rain we may move indoors for alternative activities.

For children who have completed Under 8 grade rugby training with Cork Con (or any other rugby club), rugby tackling may be coached and incorporated into some games (depending on comfort levels etc.) during the camp. Please ensure your child brings a gum shield each day if they wish to partake in such games.

Our focus is to provide a safe, respectful and fun environment for all. We would ask that at all times, all children respectfully follow the directions and instructions given by the coaches and at all times be respectful to fellow players.

All coaches at the camp have undertaken the National Garda Vetting process to comply with Cork Con and IRFU policy regarding recruiting and vetting to work in age grade rugby.

Please note all children will be "handed over" to their parent/guardian at 1pm. Please do not leave the club with your child(ren) without the knowledge of your child's coach/the camp director.

The vehicular access gates will remain closed during camp hours until 15 minutes before finish time i.e. 12:45. Access through the pedestrian gate will be possible at all times. If early collection is necessary, please enter through the pedestrian gate. Contact with a coach or the camp director must be made immediately upon entering the club grounds.

Please find below further details of the camp and all other relevant information. Please read it carefully.

Children must be aged between 6-12 years.

Coaches are not responsible for children left unsupervised outside camp hours (9.30am-1.00pm). Please inform the camp director of any changes or special arrangements regarding the collection of your child.

All children will be recorded as present/absent each morning.

Parent/Guardian must be contactable at the phone number provided at registration during camp hours.

Cork Constitution reserves the right to suspend any child that causes disruption to the camp.

Cork Con reserves the right to cancel, amend, alter, and change any camp or its content without the need for prior notice.

Cancellations made after 3rd April 2026 will not be refunded.

Cork Constitution cannot be held liable for damage to or loss of possessions. We strongly recommend that all valuables are left at home.

Cork Constitution cannot be held liable for any medical expenses incurred as a result of injury obtained on Cork Constitution Rugby Camps. It is understood that all participants take part at their own risk and are required to have their own insurance cover in place.
