- Play by the rules

- RESPECT your teammates, Treat ALL players as you would like to be treated

 - DO NOT use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender, or ability, you will be letting yourself, your family, your coaches, and teammates down, and many such comments are now illegal.
 - \circ Any form of bad behaviour to teammates, or opponents is unacceptable

 - \circ $\;$ The aim is to help everyone enjoy improving at the game

Parents Code of conduct

- Always remember you are here for the Kids to enjoy the game
- Encourage Participation do not force it
- Teach enjoyment (of all kids) is more important than winning
- Lead by example, respecting ALL players, coaches, referees, and opposition. Physical and verbal abuse is unacceptable.
- Do not shout or scream, at players, coaches, officials or opposition.
- Recognise all volunteers are giving up their own valuable time, and are aiming to help all kids.
- Never publicly criticise referees or coaches, raise personal concerns with club officials in private at a follow-on time
- Do not use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender, or ability you will let down your family and yourself if you do & many such comments are now illegal.
- Align players understanding and acceptance of the overall aims for the team, ensure non contradiction of the coaches.
 - o Ensure players understand and accept coached instructions and positions no matter their personal preference.
- Avoid coaching their child during games, enjoy seeing your child partaking a sport the enjoy no matter what they are doing.
- Give attention to all participating children not just the most talented or your own.
