### **General Information**

### Date:

• Weekend of January 20<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>

### Venues Saturday (4-Wall) & Sunday (Wallball):

• TBC

### Grading Criteria:

Ladies' Open/A:

Players must be eligible to play in Inter County Senior & Intermediate Championship Grade. Also includes players who have previously won the Ladies' B competition.

Ladies' B:

Players must be eligible to play in Junior B or Junior Championship Grade. Players must not have won Ladies' Open Singles, A Singles, B Singles, 19 & under, or 17 & Under in the Irish Nationals or World Championships.

Ladies' Challenger:

Players must have not won a provincial title at juvenile or adult level in any grade/code. Entrants to this grade will be assessed regarding eligibility. Players also may not have won the Ladies' Challenger in a prior year.

<u>Age Categories</u>:

11 & under, 13 & under, 15 & under and 17 & under girls' singles grades, player's must not have turned over the age limit by 21<sup>st</sup> of January, e.g. 17 & under players must not turn 18 before the 22<sup>nd</sup> of January 2024.

### 40x20 Format (Dark Blue):

- Ladies' Open/A Singles:
  - Open/A players are put into 4 groups (Depending on numbers). Each group plays a round robin of one game to 21.
  - A player gets 2 points if they win their game, they get 1 point if they get 11 or more points in the game.
  - Player who has most points and tops the group plays the Cup semi-finals. (2 games to 15, tiebreaker to 11)
  - Player who is second in the group plays in the Shield Competition semi-final.
    (1 game to 21)
  - Player who is third in the group plays the Plate competition semi-final. (1 game to 21)

### 40x20 Format (Dark Blue):

- Ladies' B Singles:
  - Two Round Robin groups (1 x 21) (Depending on numbers).
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> in each group qualify for Cup Semi-Finals (2 x 15, 1 x 11).
  - $\circ$  3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> in each group qualify for Plate Semi-Final (1 x 21).
- Ladies' Challenger Singles:
  - Two Round Robin groups (1 x 21) (Depending on numbers)
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> in each group qualify for Cup Semi-Finals (2 x 15, 1 x 11).
- Girls 17 & under, 15 & under Singles:
  - Two Round Robin groups (1 x 15) (Depending on numbers)
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> in each group qualify for Cup Semi-Finals (2 x 15, 1 x 11).
- <u>Girls 13 & under Singles:</u>
  - Two Round Robin groups (1 x 15) (Depending on numbers)
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> in each group qualify for Cup Semi-Finals. (2 x 15, 1 x 11).
  - 5 Serve Rule implemented. Players take it in turns to serve five consecutive serves.
- <u>Girls 11 & under Fun Singles (Challenger 2):</u>
  - Two Round Robin groups (1 x 15) (Depending on numbers)
  - 5 Serve Rule implemented. Players take it in turns to serve five consecutive serves.

#### Wallball Format (Official Irish Wallball):

- Fun Day Mixed Team Event:
  - $\circ$   $\;$  You take a player from each division and make a team of 4.
  - Playing as 2 Doubles pairings.
  - First to 25, Rally Scoring.
  - Round Robin Wallball.
  - Team with the most points wins the fun day competition.
- Mother & Daughter Doubles:
  - (1 x 21, Rally scoring, Straight Knockout)
- Mother & Others/Challenger Singles:
  - (1 x 21, Rally scoring, Straight Knockout)
- <u>11 & under Fun Doubles (Enter with Partner or Individually:</u>
  - (1 x 21, Rally scoring, Round Robin)
