Ine club has now announced its membership fees for 2019/20 Season for all players.

The coming season (2019/20) see a return to the school year season for all underage players. This in effect means the season will run from August to June with a proposed break at Xmas and holiday times. As a result the fees charged will reflect these changes. New Players/Girls will pay up to June 2020 and all Paid up existing players to Dec 2019 will then pay a half year fee in Jan 20 for 6 months to bring everyone in line in 2020.

The fees for a full Season for Boys and Girls will be:

All Players	(Junior Academies)	€170 Upfront or € 60 pm over 3 months
All players	(U8 - 11 Teams)	€275 Upfront or € 95 pm over 3 months
All players	(U12 - 17 Teams)	€310 Upfront or € 110 pm over 3 months
All players	(U18 - 19 Teams)	€350 Upfront or € 125 over 3 months
Leaders Children (all Teams)		€25 Upfront

^{*}A discount of 50e for each 2nd and subsequent child in immediate family will apply

All Registration/payments can only be done on-line only and must be completed 7 days before a player can play on the team. **Ideally all players should be registered by 1**st **September**.

The Clubs payment system is now open and accessed via the Website and Facebook channels.

Membership Fee

What's Included?

- Insurance for players scheme (FAI)
- Injury screening facility
- Training facilities at club
- Discounted rates for hire for members
- All League fees/Cup entry costs
- Player pathway development programme

What's not Included?

- Weekly subs to cover gear cleaning and referee costs
- Match transport costs
- Excess under insurance cover
- Camps, programmes, events etc.
- Club gear/uniform

Insurance cover only applies to Registered Players

Club gear

All players are required to have club gear for training, which is available in the club shop. Vouchers are given for New players as part of membership. Each player when fully paid will receive a € 20 voucher for the club shop to cover shorts/socks. Please print the receipt of and present to club's shop. For training club shorts, club socks, training top and ideally light shower top/rain jacket etc. all other gear purchases are optional i.e. bags, tracksuits etc. & not essential

All Coaches/players must wear club gear at all times i.e. matches/training etc.

Process

Players become club members on acceptance of their on-line membership form and payment of the relevant fee, after which they will be allocated to individual teams.

In addition all Leagues have requirements for registration forms and each player <u>must</u> complete these, provide a "certified" copy of his/her Birth Certificate and the appropriate fee must be paid prior to participation in any club's activity. In addition to this the club's membership form & medical questionnaire (if over 14) should be completed.

Please note no refunds will be given on fees paid for any reason other than the club is not in a position to provide football for your child at any level.

Important changes to 2019:

2019 saw the FAI National Registration in place, which in effect means all players must complete the club's membership payment on-line before any player can play. All registration are then transmitted on-line only to both the DDSL and the FAI by the club.

Please ensure your registration form and on-line is complete by <u>1st September</u> to ensure your child can play!
