The King's Hospital School is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all. To ensure that, we have developed the following COVID-19 Response Plan.

We will:

- Continue to monitor our COVID-19 response and amend this plan in consultation with our staff.
- Provide up to date information to all on the Public Health advice issued by the HSE and Gov.ie.
- Display information on the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and correct handwashing techniques and sanitising technique.
- All sports equipment will be sanitised before and after use.

- Keep a contact log to help with contact tracing.
- Ensure staff and attendees engage with the induction / familiarisation briefing provided.
- Implement the agreed procedures to be followed in the event of someone showing symptoms of COVID-19 while on the school grounds.
- Provide instructions for staff and students to follow if they develop signs and symptoms of COVID-19 during camp time.
- Implement cleaning in line with Government advice.
