

CODE OF CONDUCT - Club Year 2023 /2024

Enfield Youth Club (Freaky Fridays) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. We aim to offer a positive experience where Club Members can feel a sense of identity, gain health and fitness, enjoy teamwork, build trust, learn new things in a safe environment and have FUN!

Club Members are expected

- To show respect to other Club members and Leaders
- To sit and listen quietly when asked by Club Leaders
- To take care of Club equipment
- To play fairly and be trustworthy
- To report any bullying of their peers
- Not to engage in rough physical contact (e.g. wrestling, pulling, pushing, hitting, kicking even in play)
- Not to use offensive behaviour (e.g. spitting, bad language, derogatory comments)

Club Members have the Right to

- Be safe and happy in their chosen activity
- Be listened to
- Be respected and treated fairly
- Be protected from abuse
- Be believed and ask for help
- Enjoy themselves and have FUN!







In the event of not following these Rules, the following will occur:

- Warnings for minor incidents (eg minor swearing, running, disrespect to other club members, leaders or equipment) will be reviewed at the end of the night. A parent will be spoken to if a child has been spoken to a few times on the same night or for the same thing on more than one week
- Any serious incident will be dealt with immediately (eg violence, vandalism). The child will be automatically suspended and parents will be called to remove them from Club.
- Club Committee reserve the right to expel members from Club if their continued behaviour is deemed unacceptable and not in keeping with the Club's Code of Conduct.
