Players Code of Conduct

All players of Colemanstown United FC (hereinafter called CUFC) are in the glare of public attention, when they play. There is a considerable onus on them to speak and act in a manner which promotes all that is good about the game and CUFC. A player's behavior both on and off the field represents CUFC. The ethos of this Players Code of Conduct is incorporated into Clubforce registration on initial registration/ signing of club membership on an annual basis.

Every player, regardless of age, should:

- Make an honest effort to develop their sporting ability, including their fitness, skill, technique & tactical ability
- Strive to always set a positive example for younger players and supporters
- Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence, rough play & disciplinary issues and where possible, help injured opponents.
- Give consideration to any player who may be injured.
- Accept apologies from opponents when they are offered
- Give maximum effort during each game.
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time wasting.
- Make every effort consistent with fair play and the laws of the game
- Abide fully by the laws and rules of the game.
- Accept both victory and defeat. Be modest in victory & gracious in defeat. 'Be a sport'
- Learn from mistakes during games and training.
- Resist any temptation to consume banned substances to improve performance
- Always treat opponents respectively
- Always show true respect towards match officials, mentors and officials of the opposition.
- Show true regard for the interest of supporters
- Do not act or speak or use abusive language so as to incite or encourage supporters to act in a way that may endanger the safety of anyone attending or playing in a game.
- Do not place bets on games in which you, as a player is involved in
- When publicly expressing an opinion on a game or on players involved in a game, have due regard for the best interests of the game
- Do not cheat or cause disruption during training sessions, matches or while attending club organised events or outings
- Always show Racism the red card
