

Code of Conduct for sailing at Parkmore

- The boat park is solely for boat storage and strictly off limits during sessions to Junior members unless accompanied or instructed for a specific purpose
- Parkmore is a public, working pier which we use and share with the community - KBSC request all members to be respectful of others property. Keep clear the operational area used by the safety boats during sessions and avoid running on the wall or pier area to reduce risk of accident or serious injury
- Participants are requested to follow the instructions of club officers & delegated people in charge both on the water & on shore during sessions
- The monitoring of junior members behaviour in respect to the above is solely the responsibility of parents/guardians who should remain at the pier during sessions
- If a member is in breach of this code of conduct on more than three occasions they may be suspended from supervised sailing sessions until further notice

Note: Many junior members like to pier jump after sailing. Please note that this is not monitored by club officers during sessions and parents/ guardians should be aware if their junior member is partaking and supervise
