Rules and code of conduct

- 1. You must be a registered member of St. Michael's LGFA in order to take part in training and matches.
- 2. When a parent/guardian drops a child of at training/a match they must make sure that there is a coach/responsible adult in attendance.
- 3. Players are to treat their coaches, team mates, opposing players and referees with respect, dignity and sensitivity.
- 4. Parents/guardians are required to make themselves available to help out with their child's team on occasion with such activities as coaching, supervising, giving lifts to and from matches, sending texts, washing jersey, fundraising etc.
- 5. Parents are asked to reply promptly to coaches texts messages and to inform the coach if a player is unavailable for training or matches.
- 6. Players are to refrain from using unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage over or isolate another player.
- 7. Use of cameras in the dressing room is forbidden.
- 8. Players are requested to inform their coach, mentor or any adult member of the club if they have concerns about anything in the club.

- 10. A player failing to adhere to this set of rules and code of conduct may be suspended from training or have their membership terminated.
