- Support the coaches and referee's decisions, these individuals are only doing the best they can and they need your support.
- > At our games, be positive or be quiet.
- Do not attempt to coach players at any occasion.
- Refrain from contacting the coach unless it is necessary, respect they have a private life.
- Inform the coach about any illness, injury, school games, holidays with as much notice as possible.
- Never contact club coaches to discuss Kerry FC Academy football team matters
- There is to be no contact made with team coaches 24 hours prior match day or for 48hours post game unless it is in relation to your child's welfare or health.
- Communicate any concerns you may have to the coach, if the coach cannot resolve your issue contact Head of Academy.
- ➤ Be prepared to be asked to leave the club by club officials if your behaviour or actions do not align with points above.
