Parent and Youth Player Code of Conduct

Youth Players

- 1. Show respect for team-mates, managers/coaches, committee members, opponents, and officials **at all times.** <u>Unacceptable or inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.</u>
- 2. Always represent your team, the Club, and your family with pride and dignity. Players are expected to respect the decisions of match officials and **always** shake the referees' and their opponents' hands at the end of **every match**.
- 3. Players are expected to support and encourage fellow team members in all situations.
- 4. Players are expected to listen and comply with **all** reasonable instructions given by their manager/coach or a committee member.
- 5. Players should listen to all advice given and ask questions if they don't understand.
- 6. Players are required to wear correct club gear and equipment.
- 7. Players are required to turn up on time to training sessions and matches. If you are unable to do so, you or your parent/guardian must inform your coach at the earliest possible moment.
- 8. Players should assist coaches with equipment before and after matches and training sessions. Players must also respect and take due care of Club equipment.
- 9. Players should know that it is acceptable to talk to a Coach, the Club or Child Welfare Officer with any concerns or questions they may have.
- 10. Above all else, players should enjoy playing and training for Clonmullion F.C.

Parents & Guardians

- 1. Parents are expected to set an example by showing respect for managers/coaches, committee members, opponents, and officials **at all times.** <u>Unacceptable or inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.</u>
- 2. Parents must show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and committee members. Without them, your child could not participate.
- 3. Parents should maintain realistic expectations of their child and not put them under undue pressure. They should accept disappointment, praise good work and refrain from criticism.
- 4. Parents must respect the coaches' decisions and leave coaching to our coaches. All footballing decisions made by the coach are final.
- 5. Parents must ensure membership fees are paid in full before the start of season and all matchday and training fees (subs) are paid on time.
- 6. Parents should participate in and support club fundraising activities where possible.
- 7. Parents will ensure that their child arrives on time for training and matches and that safe arrangements are in place for getting them home afterwards.

By purchasing membership, you are agreeing to abide to all the terms detailed above. A breach of the Code of Conduct will result in referral to the Executive Committee and will be dealt with as follows:

Senior Player Code of Conduct
