

Terms & Conditions

Please note NO player can play league matches or train with Kilcock Tigers Basketball Club (KTBC) unless they have paid their membership fee in full, or have arrangements in place to pay the fee by instalments. Amongst other expenses this fee covers:

- The registration of players and teams with the Dublin Boards & Basketball Ireland.
- Affiliation fees with Basketball Ireland.
- Payment of referees.

- Administration costs.
- Costs of providing coaching, referee and table official courses for members.
- Hall rental largest Club expense.

Every effort has been made to keep the player membership as low as possible. Any additional income required by the Club will be obtained through fund-raising events throughout the year.

New members may only register with the Club on approval from the committee.

By registering your child with KTBC, as parent/guardian you are agreeing to become a member of the Club. The Team Manager of your child's team will prepare a roster for training supervision at the start of the season. It is **compulsory** to supervise training when rostered. Training will be cancelled if there is no supervisor in attendance.

KTBC accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to personal articles belonging to its members.

KTBC strongly advises all parents that children should wear a gum-shield for both training and matches. Any child not wearing a gum-shield will be assumed to have his/her parents' permission to participate without one.

By registering your child with KTBC you agree to abide by all Covid19 regulations and instructions set down by the Irish Government, Basketball Ireland and KTBC.

Terms of Playing Membership

Players are required to attend all team practices and games. They shall be excused from practice or games:

- If sick

- If injured
- Due to family commitments
- At the discretion of the Team Coach

If a player is to miss training or a game for one of the above reasons, that player must let their Team Coach or Team Manager know at the earliest possible time.

It is the responsibility of all players to organise their time in relation to family commitments, school work and to basketball. If a player has commitments to other sports or interests, it is that player's responsibility to inform their Team Coach well in advance of any clashes.

Players are provided with a playing kit for the duration of the basketball season. It is expected that these kits will appropriately cared for and must be returned to the Team Manager after the last game of the season. These kits should not be worn to training practice. Players who lose items of kit will be charged a fee of €30 for replacement.

Conditions of use of Photographs

- 1. Kilcock Tigers Basketball Club recognises the need to ensure the welfare and safety of all young people in sport. In accordance with our Club Policy we will not permit photographs, video or other images of young people to be taken without the consent of the parents/guardians and children.
- 2. This form is valid for the period of time your child attends KTBC. The consent will automatically expire after this time.
- 3. We will not use the personal details or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child or adult in a photographic image on our facebook page / website without good reason. For example, we may include the full name of a club member if the child has won an award, with permission from the parent.
- 4. A child / parent may request that their photograph be removed from the web/page at any stage.
- 5. We will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on our facebook page / website or supply them to other publications.
- 6. We may use team photographs or footage with very general labels, such as "U15 boys team photo" or "U13 girls playing against Tolka Rovers".
- 7. We will only use images of club members who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.
- 8. KTBC will take all steps to ensure these images are used solely for the purposes they are intended. If you become aware that these images are being used inappropriately you should inform Kilcock Basketball Club immediately.
