

PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT.

I **consent** to my child taking part in club activity. My child is in good health and I consider him capable of taking part in activity. I understand that whilst club personnel will take every precaution to ensure that accidents do not happen, they cannot be necessarily held responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered to my child or their possessions.

I have read the Code of Conduct for both players and parents/guardians that is published on the club website. I agree to abide by those whilst in the care of the club and I understand that any serious or continued breach of these codes may result in my child being suspended or expelled from the club. I agree to the safe transportation of my child, including being on time for training and prompt collection. I will not drop my child at the gate or road and leave without knowing if training is on or not. I also agree to abide by the Rules of the Dublin & District Underage League, Metropolitan Girls League, S.F.A.I. & F.A.I.

I agree that the Club may video/photograph my child/children whilst playing/Training or competing for Newbridge Town FC. Any video/Photograph may be used by the League in local/national papers or brochures to promote the Club and/or League as they deem fit.

First aid and emergency.

Does player have any medical conditions or allergies

It may be necessary for a member of the club to administer first aid or obtain any immediate treatment which may be required during club activity. I **consent to first aid**, including emergency medical or hospital treatment. ***IMPORTANT*** : It is essential to inform your Coach/Team Manager of any changes to your medical condition during the season.

Commitment & Other sports.

Newbridge Town FC are primarily interested in signing players whose first choice is to play soccer for the club. In completing the registration process one is confirming this and thereby will be available to attend all club training sessions and will be available for selection to play all NTFC games in the current season which commences for boys & girls on the 1st August 2020 and finishes on the 30th June 2021. Players that sign for the club but are unable to commit to the club will be ineligible for team selection and membership may be revoked.

If you are aware that you may be unable to attend matches or training due to other sports please do not sign for the club. Your inability to commit to the club is disruptive. It puts pressure on players from other teams to help your team out during matches, increases the burden on managers/coaches and result in forfeited matches and heavy fines for the team. It could/will also result in a team being folded mid season which in turn will leave players with no team and unable to transfer to another club due to league rules. Once a player registers for Newbridge Town F.C. it is strictly prohibited for that player to train or play with any other soccer club or entity (except their league representative squads).

Players will be placed by ability at most stages during their time with the club. Players could be moved between different teams. This is solely the responsibility of the manager(s) and coaches of the relevant teams - parents have no influence on the placement of players within the club and any attempt to exert pressure or influence managers or coaches regarding placement of players is strictly prohibited. Open trials will run each year for all age groups. Parents choosing to register their child in the club/program are making a conscious decision to accept the objectives and policy of the club/program.
