Since the foundation of the GAA, in 1894, the Hurlers Co-Op Draw has been a central part of the fundraising activities for well over a quarter of the journey. During this time it has contributed significant financial resources to the country's largest community and sporting organisation as our native game now reaches new horizons having been awarded Unesco Cultural Heritage status.

The journey over the past thirty seven years has seen great changes in the number of pitches being used and the amount and quality of the facilities that cater for our ever increasing numbers of players, members, supporters and their communities. It too, has seen many changes in club personnel who proudly wore the jersey as they founded, played for, nurtured, and developed their clubs. The Hurlers Co-Op draw through the late Johnny O'Shea typified this, as through his vision and drive it has prevailed and grown. An bhlian seo, its successful co-operative run legacy will be continued by Gerri Hickey, Billy Norris and their committee with the support of the club co-ordinators.

In the past year the Hurlers Co-Op Draw delivered €246,961 for many projects in the participating clubs with another €81,000 going to Nowlan Park to improve the spectator experience and facilities through the planning of new toilets and the painting of the stand, whilst the on-going upgrading, maintenance, drainage and irrigation projects on the playing surface were recognised with the Pitch of the Year Award

This year the Hurlers Co-Op Draw will be another winner all round. Johnny O'Shea



Shock and deep regret were felt on the sudden passing of Johnny O'Shea Ardclone, whose reach was felt worldwide from Piltown, throughout Kilkenny and Ireland, Europe and as far away as Arba Minch, Ethiopia. Johnny's life epitomised the old Irish Farming Proverb "Ní dhéanfaidh smaoinéamh an treabhadh duit" "that you will never plough a field by turning it over in your mind" In life Johnny worked on his innovative dreams and through his hands on approach, from his first adventure growing cabbages he built the O'Shea Farms and Iverk Produce businesses.

Johnny's life and times surrounded his family, friends and the community in Piltown where he was steeped in the GAA and where his early activities saw the Piltown 600 Club lead to the development of the Club Complex. His association with Billy Norris, Jim O'Keeffe, Sean Gorey and Gerri Hickey saw it develop into the Hurlers Co-Op Draw. The resultant co-operative venture driven by Johnny assisted so many clubs and counties as it extended to Waterford, Wexford, Tipperary and Laois. Inniu, its format has provided millions of euros for club pitches and developments in Kilkenny, Nowlan Park and across the South East.

Elsewhere Johnny's charitable works and support are legendary and many have yet to be or will never be known as he quietly supported families, clubs and communities from near and far. His entrepreneurial skills brought direct employment for hundreds and their families and even more opportunities were provided for vegetable suppliers, start up and servicing companies.

As we express our sincere sympathies to his family and comrades, we were privileged to have met Johnny and to have benefited from his enthusiasm, energy and ideas and we know that Johnny's memory and inspiration will last.

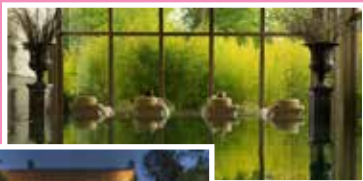
