

## Lions AFC Easter Soccer Camp 2019 - FAQ's

## Who can participate in the Lions AFC Easter Soccer Camp?

Lions AFC Easter Soccer Camp is open to boys and girls currently in primary school classes between senior infants and 6<sup>th</sup> class inclusive.

#### What is the timetable for the camp?

The camp runs from 9am to 1pm (4 hours) for 3 days from Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> April to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April inclusive.

## How do I apply for the camp?

Applications and payment can only be made online through the Lions AFC page on the Clubforce website at <a href="https://member.clubforce.com/memberships">https://member.clubforce.com/memberships</a> cart m.asp?LL ID=1872&CLB=1. Places on the camp are limited and will be accepted on a first come first served basis following submission of both the application form and full fee.

## Can I enrol my child on the day?

No. As the club must ensure an appropriate ratio of coaches to participants, enrolment on the day of the camp cannot be facilitated.

## How much is the camp?

The camp costs €30 per child for the three days.

#### Are there family discounts?

No. As the cost of the camp has been kept to a minimum it is not possible to offer family discounts.

#### How do I pay for the camp?

#### Will I come early on the first day?

No. We'll see you there at 9am on the first day and every day.

## I wish to cancel my booking. Will I receive a full refund?

All cancellations must be notified to Robbie Dempsey 087 4115971. Refunds cannot be given in respect of cancellations made within 48 hours of the start of the camp.

## Does my child receive any football gear as part of the camp.

No. In an effort to keep the cost of the camp to a minimum football gear is not included.



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## What does my child need to bring to the camp?

- Suitable sports clothing
- Football boots (with moulded studs)
- Shin guards
- Packed lunch
- Rain jacket
- Sun screen
- Name tags for your child's bag and clothing
- · Any medication your child may need

#### How long are the breaks?

Lunch will last for 30 minutes. There will be at least two 15 minute breaks in addition to the lunch break.

## Can my child leave the venue at lunch to go to a shop nearby?

No. Your child must bring a lunch to the camp. Participants cannot leave the camp between the hours of 9am and 1pm.

#### I've a tendency to be late – can my child head home on his/her own?

It is your responsibility to ensure that your child is collected at the designated finish time or that arrangements are in place to allow him/her to travel home independently. Children will not be allowed to leave the club grounds before 1pm but may leave the grounds after 1pm if they have not been collected and if they have indicated that they have permission from their parent/guardian to leave the grounds.

## What happens if it rains?

If it rains, we do our utmost to try to keep activities on track. Depending on the severity, the camp will either continue (particularly if the rain isn't that heavy and starts in the afternoon) or kids will be kept occupied with games and quizzes until home time. If the head coach deems it necessary, you may be contacted and asked to collect your child early. This is unlikely to happen though.
