For all members (players, parents, guardians & volunteers)

- 8. I understand that verbal and physical abuse is not to be tolerated against anyone in this organisation including profanity and foul language
- 9. I understand that racial epithets or negative innuendo related to a person/player's race, religion, ethnicity or physicality will not be tolerated
