Rock Celtic FC Conditions

Insurance:

Rock Celtic FC members are covered under the club's public liability and personal accident insurance. The cover only applies after a claim under any other form of personal insurance and is subject to a policy excess. The club strongly recommends that all members should arrange their own personal insurance.

Conduct:

Members must follow the instructions of the coaches in charge. Members are not permitted to leave the coaching area during the session. Misbehaviour will result in a warning to the member and persistent or gross mibehaviour will result in the member being suspended for a time specified by the committee. Parents will be informed in writing of such an occurrence.

Club Rules:

Members, parent/guardians agree to abide by the rules and Code of Conduct of the Club, FAI, SFAI, DDSL and the LSGL. Parents / guardian should refrain from showing any physical or verbal aggression towards coaches, referees , players or officials during the match or at any time. Parents / guardians are not permitted at any time on the sidelines at home games. Any breach of these rules will result in the member, parent/guardian being suspended from the club, its grounds and facilities.

SFAI Rule:

When a player becomes a registered player with a club / team in any SFAI affiliated League it shall be an offence for any official, member or any other person on behalf of another club to approach or influence that player his / her parents / guardians or any other person, in order that the player transfer to or participate in any training, coaching or games for another club.

Coaching:

The coaching session will be of duration specified by the coach and may be extended on the day if agreed with the parents. Parents are expected to collect their children no later than five minutes after the session ends.

Matches:

It is the responsibility of the member / parent / guardian to arrange to get to and from the match venue. We ask members to remember that they represent themselves, their families, Rock Celtic and ask them to act in a proper manner at all times.

Female

Female members are always welcome but in accordance with the FAI, SFAI, DDSL and the LSGL rules. All girl's teams must have a female coach/volunteer present at all times who are Garda Vetted and Child Safeguarded.

Weather:

Rock Celtic shall not be held accountable should activities be suspended or cancelled due to bad weather.

Fees:

The membership fee for a player is 1st Child €125, 2nd Child €100, 3rd Child €75 and 4th Child is free. Failure to pay membership will result in the applicant not being eligible to sign or play for the team in the season. If there are any circumstances where membership cannot be paid in full at the due date, please contact the Club Secretary.

Lost or Stolen Items: Rock Celtic FC is not responsible for any items lost or stolen at any time. This includes both at training sessions and matches (home or away).
