- Team managers will report players who break these rules to the Chairman or Secretary of the Club. Disciplinary issues will be dealt with by the executive committee. Penalties, if deemed necessary, will be applied as follows:

Yellow Card Offences - Suspension from three Club events (events include training, matches etc) Red Card Offence - Suspension from all Club activities for the remainder of year.

Mouth guards (Gum shields) are compulsory for all players in matches and training sessions
