<u>Kids.</u>

- Play fairly, do their best and have fun.

Code of Conduct: Senior Players

All Registered Players shall be registered to the Club and will be assigned to a particular panel by the senior management. Players will be expected to adhere to the below code:

- Show respect to Coaches, Officials, other teams and Club equipment.
- Encourage healthy lifestyle habits.
- Attend training and games when asked.
- When a second team is viable, the Club and Management will grade players to teams but it shallbe understood that when required, players may be asked to represent either team.
- Fines received from League for verbal or disrespecting an official will be paid by the Player.
- Smoking is prohibited on the Club Playing areas and Dressing rooms.
