Have been overseas in the last 14 days.  
Have flu-like symptoms, are feeling unwell, or have a temperature of 38C or more.  
Experience a cough, shortness of breath, or sudden loss of sense of taste or smell.  
Have serious underlying health conditions which put you in the highly  
immunocompromised category.

You must stay at home if any of the following apply:  
Have been in contact with someone with Covid-19, or a suspected case, in the last 14 days.

Players' items must be labelled with their names, and not shared.  
Players must bring their own hand sanitiser where possible.  
Goalkeepers must wear their own gloves.

Players must arrive in their training gear and with their own equipment, including water  
labelled with their name.  
Parents must not remain at the training venue  
to the venue alone if age appropriate.  
Underage players must be dropped off by a member of the same household or can arrive
