

In preparation for the reopening of Brickfields, Nenagh AFC have completed a Risk Assessment for Covid-19. The FAI has deemed our venue to be compliant with their Safer Return to Training Protocol, and all juvenile players, and a parent / guardian must read and sign the following player guidelines before training resumes. There will be a designated club committee member in Brickfields during training times to co-ordinate compliance issues such as access and egress, and attendance register.

Player and Parent Responsibilities

Players and parents / guardians are advised to keep up to date with HSE guidelines via <https://www.hse.ie/coronavirus>

Underage players must be dropped off by a member of the same household or can arrive to the venue alone if age appropriate.

Parents must not remain at the training venue

Players must arrive in their training gear and with their own equipment, including water

labelled with their name.

Goalkeepers must wear their own gloves.

Players must bring their own hand sanitiser where possible.

Player's items must be labelled with their names, and not shared.

You must stay at home if any of the following apply:-

Have been in contact with someone with Covid-19, or a suspected case, in the last 14 days.

Have been overseas in the last 14 days.

Have flu-like symptoms, are feeling unwell, or have a temperature of 38C or more.

Experience a cough, shortness of breath, or sudden loss of sense of taste or smell.

Have serious underlying health conditions which put you in the highly

immunocompromised category.
