#### Code of conduct for players

- Always be on time for training, matches or meeting.
- Accept the referee's decision and let your captain or coach ask any relevant questions.
- Respect your opponent Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not bully or take advantage of any other player.
- At the end of a match always thank the match referee and your opponents.
- Winning and losing is part of sport. Win with humility lose with dignity.
- As part of the team it is important that you attend training regularly and listen to your coach and help your team.
- Remember you are representing your team, club, family and the game of rugby.

#### Code of conduct for parents

- Remember, young people play rugby for their enjoyment, not only yours.
- Encourage your child to always play by the laws of the game.
- Teach young children that honest endeavour is as important as winning, so that the result of each game is accepted without disappointment.
- As a spectator do not use any profane language or harass referees, coaches or player.
- Do not publicly question the referee's judgement and never his honesty.
- Remember you and your child's contribution to the game of rugby are very important to the IRFU and be proud of your contribution.

## Child welfare and age grade rugby

The Club will operate in line with the Irish rugby football union guidelines on child welfare and age grade rugby. A child welfare office has been appointed by the club.

### Discipline

Where it is necessary to discipline any player or member the club has appointed a disciplinary committee to investigate and, where necessary, impose appropriate sanctions in line with the recommendations of the IRFU and the Leinster branch of the IRFU.
